Motor Vehicle Accident (MVA)/Injury Financial Responsibility Waiver

This practice(Primary Medicine of Sunnyvale) does not accept, bill, or process automobile insurance policies / personal injury claims, including Personal Injury Protection (PIP) benefits or MedPay coverage, for the payment of medical care. If your treatment is the result of an automobile accident, you are considered a self-pay patient at the time of service, or we will bill your major commercial health insurance provider subject to our in-network agreements. Patients are solely responsible for paying all copays, deductibles, or self-pay rates directly to this office. We will provide you with an itemized statement (superbill) upon request, which you may submit independently to your automobile insurance carrier for reimbursement.

- **Direct-Pay Policy:** I acknowledge that this clinic does not accept Letters of Protection, medical liens, or any third-party payment deferrals.
- **Payment Due at Service:** I understand that I am personally responsible for the cost of all medical services. All balances must be settled out-of-pocket at each visit.
- **No Legal Mediation:** This clinic will not negotiate, discount, or delay billing based on ongoing lawsuits, attorney fees, or auto insurance settlements.
- **Record Release:** The clinic will provide medical records and itemized bills directly to me. The clinic will not coordinate with or send paperwork to legal teams on my behalf.

This practice provides medical evaluation and treatment strictly for clinical health purposes. We do not provide legal statements, written injury reports, causation assessments, or forensic documentation for the purposes of personal injury claims, automobile accident lawsuits, or insurance litigation. Our medical notes are strictly limited to clinical findings and treatment plans. Patients requiring specialized medical-legal documentation, formal impairment ratings, or expert injury reports must seek these services through an independent forensic medical examiner or a designated occupational health specialist.

Please be advised that providers at this facility do not participate in legal proceedings, do not author narrative injury reports, and do not provide legal statements for car accident or personal injury claims. We will provide standard medical records and itemized billing statements upon proper authorization, as required by law. However, we do not generate customized injury reports, letters of medical necessity for litigation, or legal opinions regarding accident causation.
